

6. Learn the basics of Emacs and eev

The "basics" are these sections of the main tutorial,

```
(find-eev-quick-intro "2. Evaluating Lisp")
(find-eev-quick-intro "3. Elisp hyperlinks")
(find-eev-quick-intro "3.1. Non-elisp hyperlinks")
```

the two main keys of eev, that are `M-e' and `M-j',
the hints in the header of `M-j',
copying and pasting, that is explained here:

```
Menu bar -> Edit -> Cut (C-w)
Menu bar -> Edit -> Copy (M-w)
Menu bar -> Edit -> Paste (C-y)

```
